ROAD RESURFACING

Last year we voiced concern at the condition of the surface of many of our city roads, especially in the CPRA'S area. The County Council responded that there were no plans to resurface the roads in 2010. With the ever-increasing volume of heavy traffic, CPRA feels that the County Council needs to give greater priority to road resurfacing in Cambridge than it has in the past.

TAXI FACTS

- Cambridge has 297 Hackney and 201 private cabs, a total of 498.
- Drivers are tested by the Council and licensed each year.
- Vehicles are tested biannually and are not normally more than 4 years old.
- No vehicle over 8 years old may be used as a taxi.
- Cabs can use either petrol or diesel fuel.
